

**SEMINAR on**  
**Strategies for Water Security in Bundelkhand**  
**to Meet the Challenge of Climate Change**

**Khajuraho (M.P.): 21-23 March 2017**

**VENUE: Hotel Jhankar, Khajuraho (M.P.)**

## **General Information**

### **Registration**

Our efforts to get financial support from various organisations has not been fruitful. Hence, we request the participants NOT to ask for a waiver. The Registration Fee as mentioned above can be paid after arrival at the venue of the Seminar. Both cash and multicity cheques will be accepted.

### **Presentations**

Those interested in making a presentation should bear in mind that this is not a research seminar. Only the issues of water resources and their management and those concerned with the linkages between water and forests and climate change will be discussed in the context what needs to be done and how. We will try to arrive at some consensus on strategies for quick, cost-effective sustainable management of both surface and groundwater in the region, for achieving water security with equity and to ensure livelihoods, in the wake of climate change.

### **Travel**

Khajuraho is well connected by direct trains from Delhi (via Agra & Jhansi), Udaipur (via Ajmer, Jaipur, Agra, Gwalior & Jhansi) and Varanasi (via Allahabad). In case of the train from Delhi, if reservation is not available up to Khajuraho, one can travel up to Mahoba from where we can arrange for pick up by road (60 km).

For Air Travel, there are two flights between Delhi and Khajuraho. Air India offers a cheaper fare than Jet Airways but operates only thrice a week (Mon, Wed, Sat). Unfortunately same day return in the evening is not possible because all flights operate in the morning only.

Participants travelling by air or train can be received upon their arrival and taken to Hotel Jhankar and other hotels PROVIDED they communicate their travel plan in advance by email only (ciwsa.nie@gmail.com).

### **Accommodation**

Invited participants will stay in Hotel Jhankar of MP Tourism Dev Corp. There are many hotels within a walking distance from the Venue. The tariff ranges from Rs 800 to Rs 1500 per room per night.

Participants are requested to make their own arrangements. Some rooms will be reserved in Hotel Harmony subject to availability, and the participants can approach them by referring to the Seminar.

### **Miscellaneous**

The weather in Khajuraho around this time is pleasant. Day time is warm outdoors but the evenings are cool. Carrying some light warm clothes is advisable. Rain is not expected

There are many attractions around Khajuraho besides the world heritage temples. Those who wish to extend their stay to visit other places of interest can do so and should make their own arrangements.
